Miller Elementary School hosts first-ever Miller's Day Parade 1:15 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 22, 2022

Thomas Miller Elementary School will host its first ever Miller's Day Parade at 1:15 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 22, at Miller School, 700 S. Fourth St.

This Thanksgiving event, designed to showcase the pride the school has in its students, will involve the students participating in a sidewalk parade, greeted by parents and neighbors along the route.

Students and staff will march with musical instruments, displaying their Mustang Pride, south on Fourth Street to Kossuth, west on Kossuth to Third Street, east in front of Bauer Community Center on Fountain Street (where parents are invited to cheer them on), and back south on Fourth Street, returning to the school.

The neighborhood is invited to come and applaud the students as they walk the parade route.

Miller Principal Erin Phillips hopes the parade will become an annual event, giving the students, the neighborhood and the entire community a chance to share their Mustang Pride.

"We are thankful for our students, parents and staff and cannot wait to showcase Miller Elementary in our first-ever parade to kick off this Thanksgiving season!" she said.
