Scheduling Changes for 2015-2016

Guidance counselors meet with every student during the school year to schedule classes for the following year. If a student is interested in changing his/her schedule at the beginning of the year, he/she must QUALIFY to make changes. PLEASE UNDERSTAND THAT COURSE CHANGES CANNOT BE GRANTED FOR REASONS SUCH AS TEACHER PREFERENCE, LUNCH PREFERENCE, FRIENDS' SCHEDULES, OR CONVENIENCE. Students with qualifying reasons may make schedule changes through the fifth day of the semester. Students who request to drop a class after the fifth day of the semester must have administrative approval and, except in extenuating circumstances, will be removed with the grade W/F (withdraw-fail). Students who request a schedule change would complete a "Schedule Change Request Form" (available in the guidance office). The form MUST be signed by a parent or guardian explaining A) why the schedule change will benefit the student and B) specifically what schedule change is desired. A list of "qualifying reasons" can be found in the student handbook and on the "Schedule Change Request Form".
