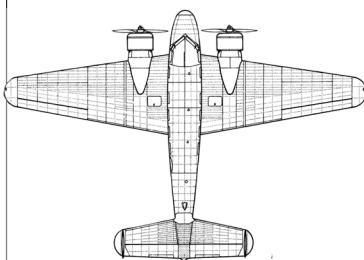

Our final fundraiser to help others is the Jar Wars contest that will be taking place May 4-13. Jar Wars supports Riley Children's Hospital.

The way it works is simple—classrooms get points for the amount of change in their jar (1 pt for a penny, 5 pts for a nickel, 25 pts for a quarter, etc.). However, students from other classrooms affect the total by adding bills to rival classroom. If someone puts a dollar bill in your jar, it is -100 points. A five dollar bill is -500 points. At the end of the contest, the classroom with the most points per student will get to turn Mr. Louk into a Human Ice Cream Sundae during Field Day Festivities.

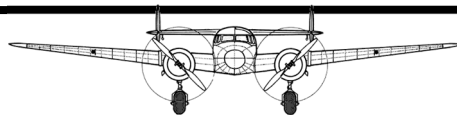
